

Work vs. Fruit Factory vs. Orchard



John 15:2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

John 15:4

As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.



John 15:5

I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.



John 15:8
Herein is my Father glorified,
that ye bear much fruit;
so shall ye be my disciples.



John 15:16

Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain.



Here's the Secret about the Spirit's Fruit

Whether "bear fruit"

or "bring forth fruit" (same word)

It doesn't mean "produce"

It means "hold" ("display")

in the Works of the Flesh?
