How does all of this work out?

- If I did not get my salvation through works
- Then I will not keep my salvation through works

Then why talk about works?

- I do not prove my salvation through works
- But I do show my salvation through works

Ephesians 2:8,9

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves:

it is the gift of God:

not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:10

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus <u>unto good works</u>, which God hath before ordained <u>that we should walk in them</u>.
