Galatians 3:19-22

A. Purpose of the Law: ¹⁹ Wherefore then *serveth* the law? It was added because of transgressions, a. Timing of the Promise: till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; A. Purpose of the Law: and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator. ²⁰ Now a mediator is not *a mediator* of one, but God is one.

B. Weakness of the Law: ^{21}Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law. ²² But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, **b. Power of the Promise:** that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.






a. Timing of the Promise Until the Seed should Come • The Seed is Jesus To Whom the Promise was Made • The Promise was Blessing
