- **A. What Was True under the Law:** ²³ But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. ²⁴ Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster *to bring us* unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

• We were kept under the Law




· We were shut up unto the Faith to come

"Schoolmaster" ≠ Schoolteacher
"Schoolmaster" = Pedagogue = Conductor of a Child



The "Schoolmaster"

- Supervisor of a "minor" child
- Instructed in morals and behavior
- Offered "round-the-clock" supervision
- Disciplined harshly and with fear
- Compare to a "drill sergeant"?

Galatians 5:2

If you learn you can <u>receive</u> salvation from God by faith in Jesus

You are right!

If you think you can <u>earn</u> favor with God with good works

You are wrong!

If you learn you can <u>rest</u> in God's favor by faith in Jesus

You are right!




A Biblical Picture

Baptism into Jesus Christ


Third Event:

- Expected <u>in</u> (not <u>for</u>)
 Salvation Event
- Confirms Salvation



3. A Symbol of Identity

Romans 6:3-4

- A symbol of death
- A symbol of resurrection
- (More next week)




3. A Symbol of Identity

- Believers are called to live through Christ



- Jesus & Disciples




Matches Bible Word
