To speak privately to recognized leaders

To make sure his gospel was accepted

### 1 Corinthians 7:19


Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.












### A Confirmation of the Gospel of Grace (6-10)

### A Confirmation of the Gospel of Grace (6-10)

Paul was Approved by the Jerusalem Leaders

James, Peter (Cephas), and John

They saw God's grace through Paul

They confirmed the ministry of Paul

They identified a diversity of ministry

#### Acts 11:27-30

And in these days came prophets
from Jerusalem unto Antioch.
And there stood up one of them named Agabus,
and signified by the Spirit that there should be
great dearth throughout all the world:
which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.

#### Acts 11:27-30

... Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea: which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

#### **James 1:27**

Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this: to visit the <u>fatherless</u> and <u>widows</u> in their <u>affliction</u>, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

### Colossians 2:13-14

And you, being <u>dead</u> in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he <u>quickened</u> together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross.
